# <u>Internal Committee Updates</u>

### Lobby Corps

From the last report lobby corps has taken stances on plenty of bills in the legislature impacting students indirectly or directly in higher education. We have supported AB 1844 (Higher Education Student, Staff, and Faculty Protection Act), AB 2683 (Sexual Violence and Harassment: Training and Resources), and AB 1701(California State University: Jump Start Program). The one bill we opposed was SB 886: California Environmental Quality Act: Exemption: Public Universities: Housing Development Projects).

- -Have asked for the Police Advisory committee to be open to the public and have a charge to review campus police policies and data

### 3.4.2 Explore with campus partners on the establishment of healing circles

- -Emailed Dr. Tina Jordan, the Assistant Vice President of Strategic Student Success Initiatives who has been conducting healing circles on campus.
- -Had a meeting with the priority group, Dr. Jordan and the Division of Inclusive Excellence
- -Held a healing circle/identity workshop with the board during mid-year retreat
- -Meeting soon with Dr. Tina Jordan and Kathrine Betts to discuss holding an identity workshop that is open to Sacramento State students
- -Sankofa Intercultural Identity Workshop scheduled for April 19<sup>th</sup> from 3pm-5pm in the Pacific Suite III (3<sup>rd</sup> Floor, University Union)
- -Priority complete

# 5.1.3 Work with campus administration to advocate for state Basic Needs and mental health funding allocation
