Project Updates

CSU Advocacy Day at the Capitol

I had the opportunity to attend CSU Advocacy Day alongside the CSUS delegation, where we met with eight legislators to advocate for the future of the California State University system. Our discussions focused on the importance of continuing to fully fund the CSU, supporting the Affordable Housing Bond to expand student housing access, and securing critical infrastructure funding. It was an impactful experience to engage directly with policymakers and advocate for sustained investment in public higher education to ensure student success and strengthen our communities and workforce.

Basic Needs/ Affordability

I was able to secure \$100,000 investment from the university into Basic Needs to support the ASI Food Pantry and the Basic Needs resource Center. With the support of the Alumni Association, it is being as a matching challenge for Give Sac State Day i.e. we are urging the community to match this donation.

Self- defense classes
