### **Project Updates**

#### **CHESS**

We participated in the California Higher Education Student Summit (CHESS), the California State Student Association (CSSA) advocacy day hosted at Sacramento State. As part of this effort, we traveled to the State Capitol to engage in lobbying and advocacy, meeting with state representatives to advocate for legislation aligned with CSSA priorities. Additionally, student participants were hosted at the Julia Morgan House alongside Dr. Wood, creating space for meaningful dialogue on student needs, higher education policy, and statewide initiatives.

#### **Basic Needs/ Affordability**

I was able to secure \$100,000 investment from the university into Basic Needs to support the ASI Food Pantry and the Basic Needs resource Center. With the support of the Alumni Association, as a matching challenge for Give Sac State Day i.e. we are urging the community to match this donation.

#### **GREEK Week**

Greek Week was coordinated alongside Executive Vice President Angulo and the ASI Greek Life Committee. A major highlight is the launch of “Wear Your Letters Wednesday,” an initiative designed to showcase and celebrate Greek life on campus through photos, music, food, Jamba, and special announcements, increasing visibility and community engagement.

#### **Sukhmani Sahib Paath**

We coordinated the first-ever on-campus hosting of the Sukhmani Sahib Path, creating an opportunity to bring the Sikh holy scripture to campus.
