Dear Hornets,

After an incredibly long and difficult semester, we are nearing the finish line and the end is in sight. I hope that everyone is healthy and doing well with everything that is going on. This is the last ASI Board Report of the Fall Semester this year, and though this semester has been difficult, our ASI Board of Directors has been hard at work. Since my last report, I have been busy conducting evaluations of all our ASI Board Members and working on filling the two vacancies that we have on our board.

In addition to this, since last board report our ASI Vice President of Academic Affairs and me have been busy advocating for the inclusion of a Credit/No Credit option this semester. Our work on this subject included multiple meetings with University Administration, the collection and analysis of nearly 5976 responses to a survey and the passage of an ASI Board of Directors resolution in support of the option. Through these advocacy efforts, we expect a full announcement soon with what options will be available to students.

For myself individually this semester, I have had many accomplishments that have directly served our students. These include my support in the planning and hosting of the University Convocation, successful advocacy for raising of the estimated COA figure, supporting our record-breaking voter registration efforts, facilitating a \$10,000 donation to student emergency grants, and continued advocacy for the student voice on a variety of issues during these challenging times. Serving as your ASI President this year has been the greatest experience in my career thus far, and I could not be more excited for next semester.

Though this semester has been incredibly difficult for all of us, the collective perseverance I have seen has been inspiring. Our Hornets are dedicated to getting an education, and each of you should be proud of the work that you have done to get this far.
