Internal Committee Updates

Lobby Corps

During the last two meetings we had a presentation from Melissa Bardo who works with the California Community Colleges Government Relations, reviewed all higher education legislation from the past legislative cycle, and conducted mock lobby visits.

University Committee Updates

Administrative Council

During the last meeting on November 9, 2021, we had our ASI Elections officer present on the importance of students running for office. We also had a presentation on the master plan update of the Ramona Plan. Next we had an Anchor Initiative update from members of the advisory council. Lastly we went over divisional updates.

Alcohol Advisory Council

The first meeting was held on October 14, 2021 where we discussed policy updates, substance sanctioning, events and programing, and Sacramento community updates on cannabis, alcohol, and tobacco.

Alumni Association Board of Directors

The Alumni Association has not had a meeting since my last report, however they did hold their Distinguished Alumni Awards on October 14, 2021 where they honored six Sacramento State alumnus.

Critical Response Team

The last meeting was held on October 25th. We reviewed issues that might arise in the need of critical response.

Instructionally Related Activities (IRA Committee)

I have been contacted by the coordinators of the committee and have set up a meeting to review my responsibilities as chair.

Intercollegiate Athletic Advisory Committee

The first meeting was held on October 29, 2021 where we received an Athletics Update from the Athletics Director Mark Orr. He went over the vaccination rates within athletics, the new proof of vaccination or negative COVID test for football games, where our sports teams are ranking. Athletics currently has a 3.0+ grade point average. The CSUS football team is currently in first place of the Big Sky Conference. CSUS Women's soccer is currently ranked 6th in the conference. Women's volleyball has had a winning streak.

Strategic Planning Taskforce

This year the campus is undergoing their review and revise of the strategic plan. It is being conducted by an outside firm who is leading the task force in the process. This committee has conducted a SWOT (Strengths, Weaknesses, Opportunities, and Threats) Analysis and reviewed the campus environmental scan. The firm is currently conducting stakeholder interviews and a campus survey to contribute to the strategic plan.

Student Fee Advisory Committee

The first meeting was held on October 29, 2021 where we received an overview of the different categories of fees and the responsibilities of the committee. We also choose the fees that will be receiving an audit this year.

UEI Board of Directors

There has been no meeting since my last report.

University Foundation Board

The fist foundation board meeting was held on October 27th where we went over the on the rise campaign. The campaign is planned to meet its goal by the end of the semester. They are planning on closing this campaign and begin another in the near future. We had various campus updates, a presentation on our Anchor Institution imitative, and another presentation on scholarship updates. The Anchor Institution initiative is focusing on six areas; Pre-K-12 education, health and well-being, homelessness and housing, arts and culture, environment, mobility, and sustainability, and inclusive economic opportunity and workforce development. It has been announced in the scholarship update that they are in the works to creating a scholarship office to be more efficient and managed for students.
