Subject: April 4, 2026 Board Report

ASI-wide Initiative:

- ASI teams are working to complete a 5-year Strategic Plan led by Gina Curry and Valerie Regner. Four pillars have been established with high-level goals, and the current effort involves departmental staff to brainstorm specific plans and initiatives.
- ASI CBA (Collective Bargaining Agreement) team continues to negotiate with the CSUEU team to seek agreements on financial and non-financial demands.

Business Administration/Accounting/HR/IT/Student Shop:

- ASI Accounting Services is nearing the completion of the FY2026-27 Operating Budgets. The final proposed operating budget plan was presented to the University CFO and ASI Finance & Budget Committee on April 7, 2026. This plan will be presented to the ASI Working Board on April 15, 2026.

The FY2026-27 Capital Budget and Student Employment Grant proposals will be presented to the Board on April 8, 2026 for approval.

- The annual audit by CliftonLarsen Associates (CLA) for the ASI pension plan – 403b has been completed and filed.
- The 990 Information Return has been filed with the IRS and CA Secretary of State. CLA presented the 990 to the Board on March 11, 2026.

ASI Government:

- The collaboration between ASI and the Campus CARC to host the Multi-Cultural Festival in Spring 2026 has been integrated into the Carnival event to take place on April 10, 2026. ASI Staff and Board members are looking forward to a successful event.
- The ASI Board Elections campaigning has begun on April 2, 2026 for the 2026-27 term. Many candidates participated in the online Candidate Forums on Friday, April 3 to pitch their candidacy. Most also participated in the Ballot Draw event on April 7 to determine the ordering of their candidate profile on the ballot on election days.
- The Spring 2026 ASI Scholarship Committee is reviewing the submitted essays and will propose the list of winners for Board approval and the April 22, 2026 meeting.

- The ASI Board members attended the 2026 CHESS (California Higher Education Student Summit) event organized by CSSA (California State Students Association) on March 20-23, 2026. The student leaders also won second place in the campus spirit competition.

ASI SEO:

- 2026 will be a milestone year for ASI as we celebrate the 35th anniversary of KSSU, the 10th anniversary of the ASI Food Pantry, and ASI’s 70th anniversary.
- April has historically been KSSU’s busiest month of the Academic Year and a big part of it is ASI Elections. On top of election Events, KSSU also hosts its own events, and continues to assist the campus with their events.
