# **Internal Committee Updates**

## Greek Life Committee

- Held two committee meetings this term: the first on September 22, 2025, and the second on October 6, 2025.
- Focused on establishing the committee's framework, defining council representation, and developing actionable goals that strengthen collaboration between ASI and the four Greek councils, including philanthropic initiatives and service-based programming.
- Discussed initiatives such as a **Greek Week of Service**, a **Greek alumni networking event**, and potential discussions around **Greek housing with District 6 Councilmember Eric Guerra**.
- Exploring the creation of a Greek Life master calendar to consolidate events and improve intercouncil communication, and the Greek Honors Program to showcase the academic achievements.
- Working with **President Aranjot Kaur and VPF Sergio Maciel** on integrating philanthropic efforts within Greek Life, supporting Giving Tuesday, and future ASI fundraising campaigns.

#### International Students Committee

- Met twice since its formation, first on September 22, 2025, and again on October 6, 2025.
- Focused on identifying international student needs, improving awareness of campus resources, and collaborating with International Programs & Global Engagement (IPGE).
- Currently planning initiatives around cultural integration, peer mentorship, and student engagement opportunities, and exploring early priority registration options for eligible students.

#### Student Social Justice & Equity Council

- Held two meetings this term: the first on September 22, 2025, and the second on October 6, 2025.
- Reaffirmed the Council's mission to promote inclusion and representation across all ASI entities.



Established partnerships with the Greek Life Committee and International Students Committee to
build shared programming that uplifts marginalized communities and strengthens student
belonging.

## AI & Digital Transformation Task Force & ChatGPT Ambassador Program

- Officially appointed to the Sac State Artificial Intelligence (AI) & Digital Transformation
   Task Force, chaired by Dean Jean-François Coget and co-led by CIO Mark Hendricks, in
   alignment with Strategic Priority 1.
- Serving alongside **Director Aadil Bhat** to represent ASI and ensure that the student perspective is reflected in campus-wide discussions on AI innovation, ethical technology use, and digital transformation.
- The task force's immediate charge includes:
  - o Co-authoring a concise vision for AI and digital strategy at Sacramento State.
  - Establishing a short list of AY 2025–26 implementation priorities.
  - Designing an operating model that supports high-impact pilot programs, training, and communication across Academic Affairs and other university divisions.
- Collaborating with faculty, deans, and administrative partners to integrate student-centered
  principles and ethical frameworks into AI-driven initiatives.
- Aligning ASI's innovation efforts and ambassador initiatives under Strategic Priority 1: Innovation & Career Readiness, to ensure AI literacy, access, and opportunity reach all students.

#### Strategic Priority 1 – Innovation & Career Readiness

- Appointed to the Sac State Artificial Intelligence (AI) & Digital Transformation Task Force, chaired by Dean Jean-François Coget and co-led by CIO Mark Hendricks, in alignment with Strategic Priority 1.
- Serving alongside **Director Aadil Bhat** to represent ASI and integrate student perspectives into the university's AI and digital transformation planning process.



- Supporting the development of a concise AI and digital strategy for Sac State, establishing AY
   2025–26 implementation priorities, and contributing to an operating model that advances innovation, ethical AI use, and student readiness for a tech-driven future.
- Serving as Sacramento State's ChatGPT Ambassador through OpenAI EDU and the CSU System, representing 22 campuses and over 460,000 students in advancing responsible and inclusive AI engagement.
- Collaborating with OpenAI's higher education team to plan campus programming focused on AI literacy, ethics, and career readiness, including potential workshops, student panels, and academic partnerships.

## Strategic Priority 3 – Justice, Equity, Diversity & Inclusion (JEDI)

- Advanced cross-committee partnerships between the Greek Life Committee, International Students Committee, and Student Social Justice & Equity Council to build a unified framework for inclusion and cultural awareness.
- Partnered with ASI President Aranjot Kaur and Cultural and Academic Resource Centers
   (CARCs) to expand ASI outreach and inclusion efforts, reinforcing DEI alignment across ASI
   operations.

#### Strategic Priority 4 – Financial Sustainability & Collaboration

- Worked with VPF Sergio Maciel and Finance & Budget Committee appointees to strengthen fiscal oversight and transparency in ASI processes.
- Collaborated on refining Election Code financial provisions, ensuring accountability and fairness in candidate expenditures and funding distribution.
- Partnered with President Kaur to explore joint fundraising initiatives tied to Give Tuesday
   (December 2025) and Give Sac Day (March 2026) through the Greek Life Committee.



• Supporting ongoing financial education and training opportunities for Directors and committee chairs to strengthen financial literacy and responsible stewardship of student funds.

- Participated in the **WSCUC Steering Committee**, ensuring the student voice is represented in institutional accreditation and student success planning.
