## **Internal Committee Updates**

### ***ASI Greek Life Committee***

- Convened February 16 and March 2 meetings to align councils and SO&L on spring execution planning, including Greek Week (April 6–10) and long-term coordination for Hazing Prevention Week (September 2026), emphasizing campus-wide collaboration and shared accountability (**Strategic Priority 3: Justice, Equity, Diversity, and Inclusion**).
- Advanced planning for Greek Week programming, including engagement initiatives and participation incentives, while preparing draft legislation to explore ASI funding support for council-led events (**Strategic Priority 4: Financial Affordability and Literacy**).
- Initiated development of a Greek Life Info Night concept to increase recruitment transparency and early student engagement, with potential implementation in late spring or summer in partnership with SO&L and campus partners (**SP 3**).

### ***ASI International Students Committee***

- Continued coordination for the international graduate recognition event, maintaining alignment with academic calendar timelines and participation capacity considerations (**Strategic Priority 5: Accessibility and Retention**).
- Preparing to increase outreach and committee visibility in advance of finalizing event logistics and expanding student engagement efforts this spring (**SP 3, SP 5**).

### ***ASI Student Social Justice & Equity Council***

- Maintained alignment with equity-centered advocacy efforts across ASI committees, positioning the Council to collaborate with the Disability Access Center (DAC) and Disability Justice Club (DJC) on student-facing programming later this semester (**SP 3, SP 5**).

## University Committee Updates

### *WSCUC Steering Committee*

- Continued coordination of campus input forums (virtual March 3; in-person March 5 and March 11), supporting facilitation structure, engagement design, and data synthesis strategy (SP 5).
- Collaborated with Steering Committee leadership to elevate student voice through ASI Board feedback facilitation, development of a targeted student survey, and implementation of a coordinated outreach plan prior to the March 13 submission deadline (SP 3, SP 5).

### *Sac State Artificial Intelligence (AI) Steering Committee*

- Participated in February 6 and February 20 meetings to refine and adopt a streamlined committee charge focused on articulating a realistic AI vision, curating a centralized resource hub, and organizing campus-wide AI forums (**Strategic Priority 1 – Innovation & Career Readiness**).
- Supported prioritization of tangible semester deliverables, including development of a research-informed AI forum and a centralized hub to surface existing AI initiatives and CSU AI Commons resources (SP 1, SP 5).
- Engaged in discussions regarding ethical implementation, governance alignment with the Senate AI task force, and advocacy for staffing and faculty support to sustain AI-related initiatives (SP 1, SP 3).

## University & Campus Partnerships

### *College Corps × ASI Recruitment & Engagement Fair*

- Collaborated with College Corps leadership to support planning and promotion of the Recruitment and Engagement Fair scheduled for March 12 on the Main Quad, reinforcing ASI's role in student workforce development and community engagement (SP 1, SP 4).

- Confirmed participation in the Alumni & Student Leadership Spotlight speaking block (12:05–12:20 pm), alongside ASI leadership, to share reflections on service, leadership growth, and the impact of College Corps (**SP 1, SP 3**).

### **California State Student Association (CSSA)**

#### *CSSA Systemwide Affairs Committee – February 21 Plenary*

- Attended the February 21 Systemwide Affairs Committee during CSSA Plenary, reviewing the finalized CSU AI White Paper and participating in a discussion regarding a resolution advocating reforms to non-resident tuition fees.
- Contributed to dialogue addressing affordability, enrollment decline, and structural barriers impacting non-resident and international students, reinforcing the importance of predictable fee structures and financial access across the CSU system.

#### *CSSA Student Trustee Committee*

- Participated in the February 13 in-person Student Trustee finalist interviews, contributing to evaluation and deliberations to ensure a fair and transparent statewide selection process.
- Assisted in the development of standardized interview questions and attended the February 27 virtual Open Forum, supporting structured finalist presentations and Board feedback submission to the Office of the Governor.

#### *CHESS & Legislative Engagement Planning*

- Participated in coordination meetings with OGA and ASI leadership to prepare for CHESS reception planning scheduled for March 21, including logistics, student participation, and program engagement strategy.
- Supported efforts to ensure meaningful student representation, structured programming, and responsible budget stewardship for the reception and associated advocacy activities.
