### **Internal Committee Updates**

#### *ASI Greek Life Committee*

- Advanced ASI collaboration with Greek Life councils and SO&L, resulting in the successful passage of legislation supporting Greek Week programming through Strategic Priority funding (**SP 3, SP 4**).
- Coordinated with Greek Life campus partners, including Program Advisor Kayla Johnson and Assistant Director Ashley Torres-Gibson, to finalize Greek Week planning and prepare a special announcement recognizing the progress of ASI–Greek Life collaboration and expanded campus engagement.
- Continued strengthening relationships with Greek councils through direct engagement, including participation in Greek Life Gavel Club to present ASI initiatives and elections, reinforcing transparency and student leadership pipelines (**SP 3**).

#### *ASI International Students Committee*

- Continued efforts to maintain engagement and visibility of the committee, with a focus on supporting international student programming and strengthening outreach as the semester progresses (**SP 5**).

#### *ASI Student Social Justice & Equity Council*

- Continued alignment with campus partners to support equity-centered programming, with a focus on upcoming collaborations with the Disability Access Center (DAC) and Disability Justice Club (DJC) to promote student awareness, accessibility, and inclusive engagement (**SP 3, SP 5**).

- Participated in the Give Sac State Day Kickoff (March 4) and subsequent campaign efforts, supporting institutional advancement and student-driven philanthropy initiatives **(SP 4)**.
- Represented ASI at the College Corps × ASI Recruitment and Engagement Fair, alongside ASI leadership, sharing personal experiences on public service, workforce development, and leadership pathways through College Corps **(SP 1, SP 3)**.
- Attended the Free Self-Defense Class hosted by the Women’s Resource Center (April 2), supporting student wellness and safety programming **(SP 3, SP 5)**.

- Visited **CSU Humboldt** during Spring Break, engaging with another CSU campus environment and gaining perspective on systemwide student experiences.
