ASI Green Team

-The committee held an Earth Day Panel focused on Environmental Justice. We had five amazing speakers and had 32 participants tune into the event. Huge shoutout to the committee, Kathryn Webb and the Environmental Student Organization for putting on a great event.

ASI Student Marketing and Outreach Committee
