#### Why can't I vote for all the candidates?

Your status (grad, undergrad) and your college (Business, Education, Arts and Letters, etc...) determines who you can vote for. See examples below.

- All eligible voters can vote for the Executive Positions (Presidential Ticket (President & Executive Vice President), VP of Finance, VP of University Affairs, VP of Academic Affairs), Cash for Clubs and Survey questions.
- Defined undergraduate students are only eligible to vote for the director of their college. For example, students in the College of Business can only vote for the Director of Business.
- Undefined undergraduate students are not eligible to vote for any college director.
- Unclassified graduate students are eligible to vote for the Graduate Director, but not for a director of a college.
- Classified graduate students are eligible to vote for the Graduate Director or for the Director of their college, but not both
- Double major students (not minor) can vote for either college they are majoring in, but not both.
- "Expressed interest" students are treated as "undeclared" and can vote for the Undeclared Director.
- "Pre-major" students can vote for the director of the pre-major college.
- Black Honors College students in a defined major can vote for either the Black Honors College Director or the Director
  of their College but not both.
- Students who have been admitted into the Black Honors College (BHC) but are undeclared majors can vote for BHC Director or Undeclared Director but not both.

(Note: You will only see candidates that you are eligible to vote for. Please contact Gerald Tubo at gtubo@csus.edu or 916-747-7409 for additional questions.)

#### Can I go back and change my vote?

You can change your vote as long as you have not confirmed and sealed your vote in the "Summary and confirm" page.

## Will my vote count if I don't confirm and seal my vote?

Yes. Your vote is automatically confirmed and sealed when the election closes.

### Can I go back and view ballots I have already voted for?

Yes via the following methods

- · Click the Poll menu, and then click the poll you want to see.
- Click the browser back arrow.
- . Click the Exit and proceed to vote summary and vote confirm page link and click the ballot link you want to go to.

#### Can I view ballots I have not voted for?

Yes, by clicking the Exit and proceed to vote summary and vote confirm page link. This page will show what polls you have or have not voted for.

#### Are my votes in this election anonymous?

Yes

#### If I don't finish or lose my connection before completing, can I go back and finish?

Yes, you can go back anytime before the election closes. However, you will not be able to change your votes if you have confirmed and sealed your votes.

### Can I vote from home?

Yes, you can vote from any computer or device with Internet access and a browser. A link for voting is on the ASI elections web page.

## What if I have a complaint about the election?

Any person who has a right to vote in this election may file a complaint as outlined in the ASI Elections Code and Fair Hearing Plan which are available on the ASI Website. All complaints are filed electronically. The form may be found on the ASI Website under ASI Elections.
