INTERNAL COMMITTEES:

ASI Finance & Budget Committee

Serving as the Chair

The Finance & Budget Committee had a meeting on February 25, 2025 in the Pacific Suite (University Union). In this meeting we were given an overview of the 2025-26 Budget and its process by the Interim Director of Finance, Mari Ruiz. Additionally we had ASI presentations from Student Engagement and Outreach, and the Government office to present their proposed budgets for the 2025-26 fiscal year.

The Finance & Budget Committee had a meeting on March 4, 2025 in the Green & Gold Room (University Union). In this meeting the Vice Chair opportunity was reintroduced to the committee for the second time this semester to allow for more students to have the opportunity, as attendance was low during the initial selection due to members still being recruited. Members interested in the Vice Chair opportunity were to send a email to the Chair noting their interest by Friday, March 7th end of business day (5 pm). We also had ASI presentations from the Children's Center and Business & Administration to present their proposed budgets for the 2025-26 fiscal year.

The Finance & Budget Committee had a meeting on March 11, 2025 in the Green & Gold Room (University Union). In this meeting we continued the Vice Chair selection process that began in the previous meeting. Committee members that indicated their interest in the position by the expressed deadline were given two minutes to give a brief elevator-pitch to the committee as to why they think they would be the best fit the position. Following the pitches, a vote was held in which John Cinco was elected to be the Vice Chair of the Committee for Spring 2025. We also had ASI presentations from the Aquatic Center and Peak Adventures to present their proposed budgets for the 2025-26 fiscal year.

ASI Scholarship Committee

Serving as the Chair

This committee will be grading, managing, and reading ASI Scholarships, and will have no set meetings but a time given to read and grade each Scholarship essay anonymously. The applications for Spring 2025 scholarships, opened up to all students on February 14, 2025, and were due on March 7, 2025 at 5 pm. Students had access to the application via their student center, ASI website and on Jotform. Applications have since closed and will be dispersed to the committee on March 21, 2025 to begin the process of grading the essays that have made it through the vetting process by ASI Government

Staff. All identifying information is redacted in the essays provided to the committee to ensure that no bias or outside influence impacts the grading process.

ASI Vice President of Finance (VPF) Grant

Serving as the Chair

This committee will be responsible for the evaluation process of applicants, and selecting the first eligible students for the textbook grant. The application for the Spring 2025 VPF Textbook Grant opened on February 17, 2025 and has closed on February 23, 2025. Applications have been vetted by ASI Government staff, and are currently being processed by the ASI Accounting team.
