**ASI Finance & Budget Committee**

*Serving as the Chair*

The Finance & Budget Committee had a meeting on March 18, 2025 in the Green & Gold Room (University Union). In this meeting we reviewed the ASI Capital Budget for the 2025-26 fiscal year. The Committee approved support for the allocations.

The Finance & Budget Committee had a meeting on March 25, 2025 in the Green & Gold Room (University Union). In this meeting we reviewed the ASI Operating Budget for the 2025-26 fiscal year. The Committee approved support for the allocations.

The Finance & Budget Committee had a meeting on April 15, 2025 in the Green & Gold Room (University Union). In this meeting we discussed the proposed legislation items “2024/25-04-Hamdani, Galinato-ASI Bridge Housing Grant” and 2024/25-4-Conejo Gallegos-Operating Rule Change 400.11 ASI Student Belonging Scholarship”. Quorum was not met, so not vote was held. The legislation items are expected to be voted on in our final meeting on April 22, 2025.

### **ASI Scholarship Committee**

*Serving as the Chair*

This committee will be grading, managing, and reading ASI Scholarships, and will have no set meetings but a time given to read and grade each Scholarship essay anonymously. The applications for Spring 2025 scholarships, opened up to all students on February 14, 2025, and were due on March 7, 2025 at 5 pm. Students had access to the application via their student center, ASI website and on Jotform. Applications were dispersed to the committee on March 21, 2025 to grade the essays that have made it through the vetting process by ASI Government Staff. All identifying information is redacted in the essays provided to the committee to ensure that no bias or outside influence impacts the grading process. There were 263 applicants this semester. Completed scholarship rubrics were submitted to ASI Government Staff on April 7, 2025. Results were presented at the ASI Working Board Meeting on April 16, 2025, and are pending approval on April 23, 2025.

### **ASI Vice President of Finance (VPF) Grant**

*Serving as the Chair*

This committee will be responsible for the evaluation process of applicants, and selecting the first eligible students for the textbook grant. The application for the Spring 2025 VPF Textbook Grant opened on February 17, 2025 and has closed on February 23, 2025. Applications have been vetted by ASI Government staff and processed by the ASI Accounting team. Awardees have been awarded the relevant grant amounts.
