The COVID-19 pandemic will be one that will be talked about for a long time! Although this has affected a lot of our students, families, and community we should be proud that we are getting through this together and one day it will be over. There have been a lot of news with Sac State and how they have handled this situation. We no longer are having an in-person commencement for class of 2020 and instead will be doing an online celebration for those students that want to participate. Provost and VP of Academic Affairs, sent out an email to students regarding students' choice of changing their letter grades to Credit/No Credit (C/NC). This will help alleviate some students from the stress this pandemic has put forth. There are three options a student can have: 1. Letter Grade (raise GPA) 2. A-C or No Credit, meaning that if you get between A-C (minus) you will receive a letter grade if anything lower you will get a no credit and therefore not affecting your GPA. Lastly, 3. Credit/No Credit (does not affect GPA). I also want to advise that students will have the option to opt-in and if at the end of the semester they receive a grade they like they can then opt back out of C/NC.

While this work has been done over the last several weeks, we at ASI are not done. Once this pandemic has gone over there will be many obstacles that students will be facing and I know that ASI will be there doing the best we can to support and help our students.

I am glad that I was able to serve students and voice concerns at Faculty Executive and Faculty Senate that helped with the choosing of C/NC and online ceremony.
