Internal Committee Updates

ASI Green Team

-The committee is working closely with the Environmental Student Organization (ESO) to host a panel of guest speakers to discuss different career paths involved in environmentalism.

Student Academic Senate

-The committee has had its first meeting with the new chair. We reviewed Campus' plans for CARmencement and the second reading of endorsing ABC/NC for the spring 2021 and summer 2021. Discussion on those items ensued.

University Committee Updates

Faculty Senate

-During the last couple Faculty Senate meetings, many pieces of non-controversial items were passed. The faculty senate then went into a second reading of endorsing ABC/NC for the spring 2021 and summer 2021. It was established that summer's status of the policy is still up in the air, but likely to be approved. Fall 2021 will **not** have ABC/NC. We ended the meeting with a discussion on planning for Fall 2021. Details emerged of all the different modalities that will be offered for the upcoming semester. Concerns were brought up and most questions on the floor were answered by Provost Perez and other administration.

Executive Committee

-During the latest Executive Committee, we were given a presentation by Dr. Ed Mills that goes into details for what is planned for Fall 2021 regarding instruction styles the reopening of various campus sectors. While we are not anticipating a full reopening of everything, students and faculty should anticipate that need to be back on campus at some point during Fall 2021. Face masks will be required, and daily cleaning will be done across campus buildings, and there will be no vaccine mandate as of yet, but could change if shown to be legally allowed. Faculty should choose the modality that best meets the needs of the students and is feasible given the circumstances for fall 2021. (Faculty are not expected to change modality during the semester unless there is a major change in campus circumstances)

Strategic Priority Updates

The ASI Board of Directors have approved the 2020-2021 strategic priorities and can be found on the ASI Website. Here is a list of what priorities I am on and below are any updates.

3.2.1 Further outreach to Sacramento community.

- -Board is sharing various resources that ASI and our campus partners offer through social media.
- -Spoke with ASI HHS director, who is leading this priority, for notes from the work so far. Need to meet with other members.

- -Spoke with ASI HHS director to get onboarded this priority, need to meet with other members.
- -Our Director of HHS has been working with Sac State Sustainability on various initiatives.
- -Green certificate program has been pitched to ASI Green Team and sustainability department.

4.2.2 Publicize awareness of Safe zone and ally trainings.

- -Priority is nearing completion, a review of what sharing strategies were successful is in order.
- -Exploring the concept of a "social justice month" where more trainings and other events similar to the subject matter could take place.

4.6.2 Sponsor a challenge to promote ASI elections for student participation.

- -Spoke with ASI President about details of this to onboard me in.
- -Having a meeting on March 17th to discuss more with the A-Team Communications and Outreach Coordinator.
