1. Co-Curricular Instructionally Related Activities

Funding for the FY 2026–27 Co-Curricular Instructionally Related Activities program has been finalized. A total of \$1,568,189 was approved for 66 programs supporting student research, academic enrichment, performances, competitions, professional development, tutoring, and other experiential-learning opportunities. ASI Board members are encouraged to review and share the funded-program information so students know what opportunities are available this year. 2. Fall 2026 Financial Deadlines

Several important Bursar's Office deadlines are approaching:

- September 18: Last day to enroll in an Installment Payment Plan.
- September 28: Census date and final deadline to add or drop classes for the term.
- October 11: Installment payment due.
- October 16: Bookstore Loan payment due.
- November 4: Deadline to withdraw from the University and remain eligible for prorated registration-fee charges.
- November 11: Installment payment due.

The financial-aid deferment and regular online add/drop deadlines passed on September 11. Students with an outstanding balance may be subject to late fees or account holds. 3. Summer facilities projects update

Facilities Management undertook a broad portfolio of campus improvement and infrastructure projects during Summer 2026. The work supported student spaces, accessibility, campus safety, academic facilities, housing infrastructure, athletics, and deferred maintenance. Some projects include:

- ADA restroom remodels Capistrano Hall North and Sequoia Hall; a new all-gender restroom and lactation room in the University Library; and classroom or interior renovations in Lassen, Sierra, and Solano halls.
- Elevator upgrades at Kadema Hall; and floor repairs in Shasta Hall.
- Exterior reconditioning of Riverview Hall, refurbishment of Parking Structure 1, and replacement of the Riverside Hall roof.
