HEERF Emergency Funds Update

Since August 26, 2021, the Crisis Assistance & Resource Education Support (CARES) office has distributed just under \$500,000 in Supplemental HEERF monies to students this semester to assist with campus debt, food and housing (including utilities) assistance, health care, child care, technology, transportation and course materials. This is above and beyond the additional disbursements that went out to students earlier this semester.

The purpose of Supplemental HEERF monies is to provide financial relief to students who have experienced loss of income or added expenses as a result of the pandemic. Congress intended for students to use the funds for expenses related to disruption of their studies caused by the COVID-19 pandemic.

Note: HEERF II emergency grants are when the federal government provides funding to college and universities. This is not an ongoing federal aid program.

Hornet Laptop Discount Program Update

While I posted information regarding the Hornet Laptop Discount Program in my last report, I wanted to share with the board that of the \$5 million allocated for this program, we have used roughly \$3.4 million thus far (as of Oct. 22) to enhance student technology and availability. This program is scheduled to run through Mar. 22, 2022.
