Internal Committee Accomplishments

ASI Marketing Committee-

This committee's efforts are focused on providing promotion and awareness to all the distinct ASI Departments. The departments include Peak Adventures, Children's Center, Government, Business Office & Student Shop, HR, Aquatic Center, and Student Engagement & Outreach: Marketing, Events, KSSU, Safe Rides, Food Pantry.

During the year, we worked on planning and executing a numerous number of events focused on ASI's 65th Year Anniversary. There was two ASI Alumni Panels one in the fall and another in the Spring that showcased distinct panelists that were past ASI employees, student board members, or student workers. The individuals shared their story of what their life was like being involved in ASI and how that helped shape them into who they are today. There was an opportunity to share with the student body at the ASI 65th Anniversary Celebration where there was free food, activities, and crafts everyone could participate in. As well the ASI Marketing constantly received updates on the efforts that each individual ASI department was working on to help students and engage with them.

University Committee Accomplishments Campus Educational Equity Committee

This committee focuses on educational equity which means providing equality of education for all students. This committee reviews and provides recommendations of Educational Equality programs and activities within the University. While being in this committee along with other administrators and staff we considered new directions and ways to improve the efforts of Equity.
