Report to the ASI Board of Directors April 28, 2021

University CFO Designee – Gina Curry

1. **Fall 2021 Registration** - Registration for Fall 2021 began this Monday, April 26th. Please remind your constituents to check their accounts for Spring 2021 charges/holds ***SEVERAL DAYS BEFORE*** their registration date.
2. **Student Fee Advisory Committee** - The Student Fee Advisory Committee completed their discussion of the fee audit and accepted the recommendations of the auditor. The audit report recommendations will be go to the President this week for approval. Thank you to student members Noah Marty, Nick Mahedy, Joshua Bozarth for their consistent work on the Committee this year.
3. **Summer Session Campus Mandatory Fees** – The campus mandatory fees for summer have been reduced to a total of \$140. The Union/WELL fee was removed from the total again this year. The Student Health Center Operations and Facilities fees, in addition to the ASI fee, will still be charged.
4. **Supplemental Grants** – Please be aware that supplemental funding beyond this emergency grant is available by application. Please encourage students still in need, to apply. More information on the supplemental application can be found on this web page: <https://www.csus.edu/student-affairs/emergency-student-information/heerf-emergency-grants.html> This supplemental funding may also be available for students whose federal status does not make them eligible for HEERF. The University has identified funds to aid those students in addition to the federally eligible students and they use the same application for supplemental funding.
5. **UBAC** – The 2021/2022 budget process is underway and Divisions are presenting before the Cabinet and the University Budget Advisory Committee (UBAC) over the next several weeks. The University awaits the Governor’s “May Revise” of the State Budget before making any recommendations on the final budget for the President’s approval. That usually occurs in early- to mid-summer.
