Report to the ASI Board of Directors September 9, 2020

1. **Campus Safety** – The Risk Management and Environmental Health and Safety (Risk) Departments have been working hard over the summer to establish protocols for the safe “return to campus.” As you are aware, that still limits the folks who can be on campus. Classes and departments were required to present a safety plan, which is then reviewed and revised or approved. The Governor has proclaimed the campuses as public spaces, therefore requiring masks in all areas (even outside) if distancing cannot be accomplished. Spaces are reduced in capacity to help with distancing and cleaning protocols are increased. Safety Ambassadors, a student assistant crew, have been deployed to help with flow, door opening, elevator management, information and general assistance related to safe use of the buildings. 2. **CSU Board of Trustees** – The CSU Board of Trustees (BOT) meeting is September 21st and 22nd. There are 2 items of interest involving finance on the agenda this month. Sacramento State has 1 agenda item on the Committee on Finance Agenda. <https://www2.calstate.edu/csu-system/board-of-trustees/past-meetings/2020/Documents/July-21-22-FIN-Binder.pdf> It is for development of 2 projects on the Ramona Avenue property. They are both Public-Private Partnerships projects with outside folks bearing the cost of building and operation. One is for the Northern Region Consolidated Forensic Science Laboratory Campus which is part of the State Department of Justice. This building and program will benefit the Criminal Justice program. The other is the California Mobility Center which will benefit Engineering and Business programs. Additionally, the Committee will be discussing and setting the tuition for the Doctorate of Occupational Therapy, a new doctorate program for the CSU. 3. **2-Step Verification with DUO** – Campus is in its final push to get all students on DUO. DUO is the product that Sac State uses for 2-Step Verification which is one of the highest levels of security available for your personal information. We have the highest number of students in the CSU using DUO, as of the summer, at over 17,000 students. However, DUO will now be mandatory for students, so the rest of the more than 40,000 students who can log in to My Sac State will be required to complete the DUO enrollment and use, if they have not yet done so, by **October 5, 2020**. DUO is already required for all staff and faculty. Please encourage your constituents to enroll today, and not wait for the deadline.
