• Chancellor's Audit. We continue to work to close out all the remaining outstanding items in the Chancellor's Audit. A big shout out to Humberto Perez from the Business Office for doing a lot of the heavy lifting in closing out all the items.


Free dinner will be provided for you and your child 6-6:30pm on all dates.

## Peak Adventures

- The outdoor trip program has been a success. 18 trips were scheduled for this semester. The September trips all sold out.
- The bike shop has experienced an increase in users/purchasers this term. A positive impact of moving to the University Union. We will need to calibrate and learn what the programs new "normal" is going to be.

## o SEO

- In September we saw 1,254 food pantry visits (our largest month ever) from 705 distinct students (largest number ever).
- We fed 2,517 people with the food coming from our Pantry as we ask them how many people they are serving. See attached graphic from EAB for September numbers.
- From the start of the academic year (Aug 26), we saw 1,434 visits with 753 distinct students
  - 12% were students who live on campus
  - 13% were transfer students
  - 8% were international students
