### **ADMINSTRATION & DEPARTMENTS**

• All Departments. All Departments are currently putting together their second budgets that will take into account COVID-19 impacts on our programming. Notably, this second budget will eliminate any summer revenues for July and August 2020. We hope to bring this second budget to Finance and Budget committee next week and for Board passage and review the following week (the date of the last board meeting).

#### Board of Directors –

ASI 2020-2021 Annual Budget was approved by the Board of Directors on April 15, 2020. This
was the "first" draft of the budget that includes no impacts due to COVID-19.

### Department Highlights

- ASI Business Office Mark Montalvo and his team have been very busy applying for the CARES Act Stimulus funding. We needed to apply to become a client of RiverCity Bank so that they assisted with our funding application. Samantha Elizalde, in her role as Board Secretary, assisted with the application. Mark is now busy with working on the second version of the ASI Budget. We have a meeting with President Nelsen on Friday, May 1<sup>st</sup>.
- ASI Student Shop Has moved it services on-line. Students may order their cap and gown regalia via the Jostens website to participate in virtual graduation occurring on June 6, 2020. - Government/Elections ASI Elections were held on April 15 & 16. Voter turnout was 6.5%. Congratulations to all the new incoming board – including four current Board members! I want to thank the Elections Planning Group for quickly transitioning the elections process to an online process – including hosting virtual campaign statements and hosting online competition to encourage get out the vote efforts.
