# Department Highlights

# • Business & Administration –

- ASI department directors are in the process of drafting their 2020 2021 budgets; first draft budgets are due to Director of Finance & Admin, Mark Montalvo, by February 24, 2020.
- Chancellor's Audit has almost concluded we are only waiting on closing out is the executed Aquatic Center agreement between State Parks and the Sac State campus. The agreement is in final legal review with State Parks and it is estimated to be ready in approximately 4-6 weeks.
- We have hired the vendor "Payscale" to conduct a wage/salary analysis for our full-time and hard-to-fill positions. The goal is to include any wage increases in the 20-21 budget that will be presented to the Board of Directors.
- We will begin review of the ASI benefits in the coming month with our broker, Gallagher.

# • Government Department –

# Student Engagement and Outreach

- Due to budget constraints, CSUS Athletics has decided to not renew its MOU with KSSU starting next fiscal year. This MOU was for approximately \$28,000 and funded 5 student employees. KSSU has reworked its staffing and will move forward with 2 student employees positions, eliminating the work conducted for Athletics in broadcasting and DJing at football games.
