ADMINSTRATION & DEPARTMENTS

- Please check the ASI Website with up-to-date updates on what each department is doing. Things are changing rapidly, daily and hourly at times.
- All of ASI has been busy finalizing departmental Business Continuity Plans (BCPs) so that we are ready to move virtual, if deemed necessary
- Central to my work this past two weeks is preparing ASI for handing the Coronavirus (COVID-19). I
 have been in communication with all of the ASI Full-Time staff on moving our services to virtual. In the
 process of moving all our programs virtually including the Government Office. Elections will
 continue.
- I attended the CHESS Reception on campus on Saturday, March 7th and the Advisor's Conference at CHESS on Sunday, March 8th I attended the ASI-Advisor's meeting on Sunday and discussed the <u>San</u> <u>Marcos</u> litigation case at length.
- I continue to sit on the Centers for Diversity and Inclusion Director-search team. We have had two oncampus interviews, one is left for next week, which will be conducted virtually
- Mark, Maria and I continue to work on the Payscale wage adjustments for our full-time staff
- ASI's Census collaborations will need to move virtually as well to spread the word about the importance of filling out the Census 2020.
- Department Highlights
 - **Business & Administration** Budget development continues
 - Working on determining schedule of who will be deemed "essential" to come to campus. This includes payroll, Human Resources.
 - Working with our Employment Attorney to determine procedures for Missed Meal Break waivers and processes and policy revisions.
 - Children's Center
 - Closing childcare services as of March 17th. Front office will remain open and teachers will be in their classrooms thoroughly disinfecting spaces.
 - Student Engagement and Outreach-
 - Will move all services virtually, except the food pantry, which will open for limited hours. Three days a week – Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday.
 - New Food Pantry Hours: Tuesday: 10:00am-1:00pm, Wednesday: 1:00pm-4:00pm, Thursday: 10:00am-1:00pm
