A special thanks to Savannah Potter and Kit Baer for their work on the Report and department directors' highlights of their departments' accomplishments. It looks beautiful and I will share a copy with you when it returns from the printer.
 - Full Time Minimum Wage Adjustments. In consultation with ASI Director of Finance & Administration, I have been assessing the financial impact of both the increase in California's minimum wage from \$14.00 per hour to \$15.00 per hour, effective January 1, 2022. We will be in compliance with mandated minimum hourly wage changes. I have been working on putting together the Full-Time employee minimum wage impact and ensuing compression.
- SEO Food Pantry Food Pantry attendance is slowly increasing at times doubling from week to week, as reach a new normal. In the month of October 2022, the Pantry had a total of 838 visits to the Pantry.
 - Thanksgiving Food Basket SEO is currently fundraising for Thanksgiving Food Baskets, both for complete food baskets and monetary donations to mail out gift cards to students not living in the Sacramento region. Please consider donating to help ease the stress of the holiday season on our students.

 - Chancellor's Visit. The Chancellor had a successful visit with ASI on November 3rd. Chancellor
 Castro was able to visit with several members of the Board, and Wil, Samantha and I got to visit
 with Mrs. Castro to discuss the food pantry and the Children's Center. I also attended the Open
 Forum held in the afternoon of his visit.
 - Children's Center. The ASI Children's Center continues to be successful in providing childcare services to our students. We continue to operate a about half-capacity during these times, but we are looking to open two additional classrooms in the Spring semester to expand capacity a little bit more. There are approximately 100 children currently being served at the Center.
 - Aquatic Center. Entering the slow season or the Aquatic Center with 1,059 rentals in October which includes 53 Sac State students.
