Internal Committee Updates

Lobby Corps:

March 13th:

Overviewed CHESS 2025. Discussed notes from different lawmakers' and their meetings. Action items were AB 9 (Quirk-Silva) regarding transfer students; SB 98 (Perez) regarding immigrant enforcement and notifying college campuses; AB 90 (Jackson) regarding overnight student parking. These bills were all passed. Discussion items were SB 271 (Reyes) student with dependent children; AB 49 (Muratsuchi) school sites and day care centers with immigration enforcement; AB 1098 (Fong) undergraduate/graduate students with pregnancy; and AB 700 (Caloza) Public Service Educational Loan Forgiveness. *The Ethnic Studies Student Association* requested support from Lobby Corps in their opposition to AB 1468.

March 27th:

Discussion items: SB 685, SB 244, AB 556, AB 1468.

Motioned to move AB 1468 as an Action Item. Passed in opposition of AB 1468. Guest Speaker was Shawki Moore, from the President's Office. Discussed his journey to Higher Education.
