Project Updates:

Basic Needs Center

- *Now set to open end of Spring Semester*
- *ASI food pantry and Basic Needs Center have been working together to figure out logistics on both centers operations*

Timely Care

- *Currently working with the University to implement a new mental health service that would provide students with after-hour support, including weekends, holidays, and after-school hours. Students starting late April will be able to meet with a licensed therapist and doctor within 5 minutes compared to our 2-4 week wait. This program will offer peer-to-peer support, textNOW support, and unlimited appointments.*

Upgrading Classrooms Project

- *Currently working on identifying classrooms that need accessible tables and chairs. The University allocated 1.4 million dollars to enhance outdated classrooms and to purchase more accessible tables and chairs. I have been working with all the College Deans to identify those classrooms.*
