- III. **ASI COMMITTEE UPDATES**
 - **President:**
 - The president wants to change the operating rules to have an elected official sit on the City Ambassadors Committee.
 - She would also like to expand Lobby Corps more into the political realm of the state capitol.
 - **Executive Vice President:**
 - The Green Team was contacted by Sustainability to help with Earth Day
 - The Social Justice and Equity committee is having trouble with meeting quorum so the EVP will try reaching out to professors about recruiting more students.
 - **Vice President of Finance:**
 - The Finance and Budget Committee has been having budget presentations from each ASI Department. They are currently working on the Student Employment Grant.
 - The ASI Scholarships will be closing on March 17th so the committee will be working on grading those scholarships. The EVP mentioned that the Directors' Scholarship is very low on applicants at the moment, but the VPF mentioned that there is no need to worry at the moment.
 - **Vice President of University Affairs:**
 - The Wellness, Safety, and Sexual Assault committee is working on planning more events on campus. The committee was able to reach \$705 so far for the Out of the Darkness event.
 - **Vice President of Academic Affairs:**
 - The Faculty Senate is currently looking at the Area D requirement language but there seems to be pushback from faculty. The VPAA will have the Student Academic Senate assist with this issue.
 - The VPF mentioned that a lot of colleges are underrepresented in the Student Academic Senate.
 - The VPAA responded saying that she did reach out to the directors last semester, and it resulted in a really good turn out, but the membership stopped coming to the meetings.
