- There are multiple committees for various things such as graduation, general education, transfer credits, etc.
- The ASI President or University President can send a memo to Faculty Senate if they want something to be discussed or if they want to advocate for a change in policy.
- If the Academic Senate wants to make suggestions to the Faculty Senate on something they should consider discussing we can work with ASI to create a resolution, then take that to the Faculty Senate to show that other students are also advocating for this change.
