 - Originally the estimation was around \$147 thousand, and now it is at approximately \$227 thousand
 - Must move forward with project so it can be completed during Summer Session

Budget

 The Children's Center Budget was approved and is awaiting for the President's approval/denial

Conference

 Sherry Velte attended the Program for Infant and Toddler Care (PITC) conference from May 2-4 in San Diego

- The conference was very informative with a big change of child's temperament research; the old research is no longer valid
 - > It was concluded that temperament is developmental and changes over time

Registrations

- o Finals Week and Summer registration is complete
- This year the process was done differently to not allow current families to 'block' days and hours out; we wait until the parents register and then they update their schedule
- o Subsidy will not be available from May 28-June 30 during our summer session
 - Subsidy will be available July 1

• Center will apply for more state funds

- o The goal is to have subsidy 12 months (year-round)
 - This may make less space for full-cost and faculty families
