B. Vote

1. Sibling Discount

Committee voted to have sibling discount remain at 10% for youngest child. These changes will go into effect May 29.

C. Parent Handbook

Sherry and Nancy have decided to separate the parent handbook into two parts.

- 1. Full Cost Handbook for families
- 2. ASI State Funded Handbook for Families

This decision was made after the CMR visit in April 2018.

D. <u>Updates</u>

The CMR visit created new policies:

1. Subsidized care is now under a 12-month eligibility-ruling

period. This means children can stay enrolled in the program after their parents graduate, as long as they can prove they still have the need.

- 2. Late fees. We can no longer charge subsidized families late fees/drop-ins during operation hours.
 - a. As a penalty for dropping off/picking up late
 - i. First Offense: Note from Nancy
 - ii. <u>Second Offense:</u> Meeting with Nancy
 - iii. <u>Third Offense:</u> One day suspension from child care, counted as an unexcused absence
 - iv. <u>Fourth Offense:</u> Referred to the Dean of Students, with one day suspension; counted as unexcused absence
 - v. <u>Fifth Offense:</u> Termination from childcare services.

- 3. Center can no longer ask for donations from subsidized families, as well as make families attend orientation, meet the teachers, or attend visiting hours.
- 4. **Cook.** Position of cook is now vacant; we have interviewed three candidates already.
- E. Day on the Quad April 26th
 - Event went; many parents volunteered for set up and take down of event.
- F. **Open House** May 4th
 - Many families participated in potluck as well as karaoke!
- G. Employee Appreciation May 9th and 10th
 - The Children's Center provided food to student staff members all day to show appreciation
- H. <u>Summer Session</u> May 29th
 - Summer Session includes increase of Children's Center tuition.
