B. Current Center Updates

1. Staffing

- Current vacancies: 1 Associate Teacher and 1 Floater Associate Teacher
- Earlier in the year our Mentor teachers were promoted to Program Specialists, each one specialized in I/T or PRE.
 - Mentor teacher, Theresa Gropp, promoted to Associate Director of Operations, is currently still learning her role
- Nancy Lopez is the Associate Director of Administration; she will also manage the facilities coordinator once we fill that role
- It has been exceptionally difficult to find students /people with their permits
- The Children's Center is collaborating with the CHAD department to educate them in their permit
- Student- Natalie Rueb had been promoted to Associate Teacher

2. Facilities

- Playground renovation talks started years ago
- In 2021 we received a million-dollar grant from Kevin McCarty
- ASI has agreed to cover the difference
- We received a grant from Cal-Fire, extended the funds until February 2027.
- Hoping to break ground for the playground in April 2026, plans are still under review
- Replacement of fire panel current does not meet current code, hopefully that will be done by November/December
- The center just had lead testing done on all water faucets, one of the kitchen sinks that is only used for dishwashing will be replaced

3. Quality Improvement and current areas of focus

- Working on teaching teams and collaborating because of all the new staff we have hired
- Taking the teachers through quality interactions
- Bella room has been made into a space for families to reset, relax, play and engage with their child.

4. Collaborations

 Dr. Ciohba McKeown and her team (infant/toddler & life skills lab) is extremely helpful providing support to the children Dr. Mckeown explains her research is to show the children how to be empathetic to their peers, to ask if they're okay and be respectful with their boundaries

5. Events

 - o No celebration of religious holidays, no costumes allowed
 - We are currently working with fraternities/sororities to donate pumpkins
- Family Luncheon 11/25
 - o Center will cook food for family's "potluck" style
