### **B.** Current Center Updates

#### 1. Hiring – Challenges with buildings/training/recruiting

- 2 New Associate Teachers have been hired
- Miranda Villalobos (C2) 2 weeks in
- Anely Rangel-Ramirez (LC2) begins mid-May, we will still have one more vacancy for an Associate Teacher
- We will be backfilling in May for student staff who will be vacating due to graduation

# 2. CSUEU Allegation and Investigation

- Child Safety is top priority
- Sherry Velte has submitted her retirement notice beginning May 1 until then she will still be on admin leave
- Investigations show no findings in abuse, no intentional discrimination found either
- Some behavior and misconduct that was inappropriate for a child center director was found
- Associate Director, Samantha Subuyuj will be Interim Director

#### 3. Playground renovation

- Contracts did get signed (Yay!)
- Received approval from Chancellor's office & Internal Campus Review
- In progress for final approval DSA is looking for ADA compliance
- We will work with Licensing to find alternative spaces during the construction
- ASI has allocated 1.8 million to help complete the project
- We must complete all work by by March 31st, 2026 or Cal Fire funds go away
- CC has also partnered with the Department of ED to receive funds which have to be completed by December

#### 4. Audits

- CC had no findings in the Chancellors audit
- CACFP minimal findings such as typos or miscalculations
- CC has submitted corrections and will remain in good standing
- Overall, analyst said the Children Center is doing exceptionally well

#### 5. National Week of the Young Child - April 5-11 recap

- Successful turn out with the Free Vision screening for all Casa children
- Great turn out for tours, lots of CHAD students had the opportunity to see the center
- All teachers felt the appreciation from the parents who hosted a brunch for them
