

Get Your Flu Shot

Protect yourself and others from the flu.

Sutter Health Plus covers flu vaccines with no member cost share.

This year it is especially important to protect yourself and those around you from the flu by getting a flu shot. The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention recommends everyone six months and older should be vaccinated annually. The vaccine is particularly important for those at high risk of severe complications from the flu, such as pregnant women, children under age five and adults over age 65.

For your convenience, flu shots are available at the following locations at *no cost**:

- Sutter Walk-In Care**
 For members six months and older, appointments are recommended, but not necessary.
- Network pharmacies**
 Please call ahead to check for availability and ask if you need to schedule an appointment.
- Primary care physician offices**
 Schedule an appointment with a participating provider or Sutter flu shot clinic through My Health Online.
