Our Purpose



Our purpose at the ASI Food Pantry is to help alleviate the hunger crisis on campus and decrease the negative impact that food insecurity has on the academic success of our student community



The ASI Food Pantry provides food and basic necessities, at no cost, to Sac State students facing financial challenges and food insecurity. We also connect students to additional resources on & off campus for further assistance.

What is "Food Insecurity"

- Food insecurity is a situation when an individual has very limited or uncertain access to nutritious and safe foods because of lack of money or other resources.
- Students who suffer from food insecurity are more likely to have lower grade point averages than students who do not experience food insecurity.
- These students also tend to suffer from anxiety, fear, fatigue and suicidal feelings



Sac State's Food Insecurity

At Sacramento State:

- 47% of students said that they struggle with food insecurity
- 12.6% of students say they experienced homelessness at some time in their college careers

Food Pantry Volunteer Description

 Under direct supervision of the ASI Food Pantry Coordinator and Food Pantry Assistant, Food Pantry Volunteers support the mission of the ASI Food Pantry by donating valuable time and energy to help operate the pantry, communicate with student users, assist with stocking, and distribute food during Free Groceries Pop Ups.

Volunteer Responsibilities



3 Main Roles

Food Pantry Volunteer: Assist during open hours at the Pantry. Volunteers will greet and help students when they come in, pay attention to the specific needs of each student, explain what the ASI Food Pantry is and how it works & help keep shelves neat and organized.

Stocking Volunteer: Help unload deliveries into the ASI Food Pantry. Volunteers will help sort through items, label items and organize the food onto the shelves.

Pop Up Volunteer: Help during the Free Groceries Pop Ups. Volunteers will be hands on with produce distribution.









Who can volunteer?

Anyone over 18 years old can volunteer. You do not have to be a Sac State Student to volunteer.

Volunteers will be required to show proof of covid-19 vaccination status

Students who need to fulfill service-learning credit are encouraged to volunteer

Anyone passionate about alleviating hunger within our student community!



Policies

Towards Clients

- Be respectful, courteous and cordial
- Greet and help students when they come in
- Pay attention to specific needs of each student

Confidentiality

- Do not give out any personal information regarding students
- If you see student clients outside of Pantry, only engage with them about the Pantry if they initiate that conversation

Policies Cont.

Dress Code

- Dress neatly and appropriately
- Be conscious of personal hygiene and potentially offensive clothing
- Closed toed shoes MUST be worn at all times for your safety!

Cell Phone Usage

- Please do not use your cell phone while at the Pantry
- If cell phone use is necessary, find a private space or go outside once you have finished helping the students

Policies Cont.

Drug and Alcohol Use

- Volunteers will be dismissed immediately if found to be under the influence of any illegal substance
- You may not bring any drugs or alcohol to the pantry premises under any circumstance

Hygiene

- Volunteers must wash their hands!
- If restroom is not accessible (Pop Up) make sure to utilize hand sanitizer
- Wear a face mask (covid)

Attendance

• If you are absent to 2 or more of your shifts, we will assume your absence as a disinterest and cancel the rest of your hours for the semester.
