**2025/2026-05-124/ Lopez – 2025-2026 ASI Human Resource Policy Manual
Updates**

Discussion was had. Amy from the ASI Human Resources department provided additional information.

2025/2026-05-125/ Maciel – Allocation of Additional Alternative Transportation Funds for Peak Adventures Bike Discount Program

Discussion was had. Valerie from ASI Peak Adventures provided insight to affordability for alternative transportation funds, usage will be allowed for discounts. Moving funds to unrestricted bucket of funds.

2025/2026-05-126/ Lopez, Galinato – Operating Rule Change 200.1 Officers of the Board of Directors and 400.1 Internal Committees & Work Teams

Discussion was had. Business club union is an internal ASI committee. Clarified language in operating rules thus academic policies be directed Vice President of Academic Affairs (VPAA). Provided cleaned up language throughout VPAA operating rules.

2025/2026-05-127/ Galinato – Resolution in Opposition of the Proposed Changes to Title V in the California State University System

Discussion was had. Legislation was read in its entirety. Student academic senate supported document. Opposition of authorized baccalaureate degrees fewer than 120 semester units for potential two tiered system. Chair Gibbs provided further insight from Board of Trustees, allow additional degrees to meet minimum of 90 semester units for flexibility and affordability. Gearing national movement towards career development, the component of higher education is entrance into the work force, gaining real world workforce experience.

2025/2026-05-128/ Galinato – Resolution Outlining Stances on California State Legislation (5.6.2026)

Discussion was had. Support if amended, if the legislation changed then stance will be taken. Legislation was read in its entirety.

2025/2026-05-129/ Kenndey, Galinato, Kaur, Angulo – Resolution in Support of Reviewing Disability Accommodations Procedures at Sacramento State in Response to Concerns Raised by Students with Disabilities

Summary was provided, current process for accessing accommodations is not meeting student's needs and are seeking attention to the procedures from start to finish. Concerns include if appropriate procedures are being met, appeals process as there is no consistent expectation, degrading equitable access. Public comment provided board with the opportunity for education on access coordinators process. Chair Gibbs provided insight for faculty support in knowledge of training around accommodations, restriction and student support. Assistant Director of Disability Access Center (DAC) provided services available, recommendation for collaboration on legislation. Executive Director Hoan Nguyen recommended passing legislation and amending to bring forward to incoming board to collectively work with stakeholder, sensitive topic. Public comment was provided.

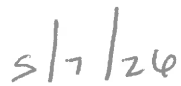

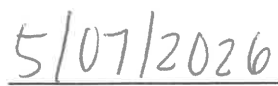
