I scouted locker locations based on the recommendations from key observers (long time staff/volunteers) and the specifications Lux One Lockers provided on set up/best use. I took photos of potential locations for the lockers and made an Executive summary on my findings including the different locker types, locations pros and cons, and future research questions that can help determine the Lockers Location and the needs of the students who use the food lockers.
